

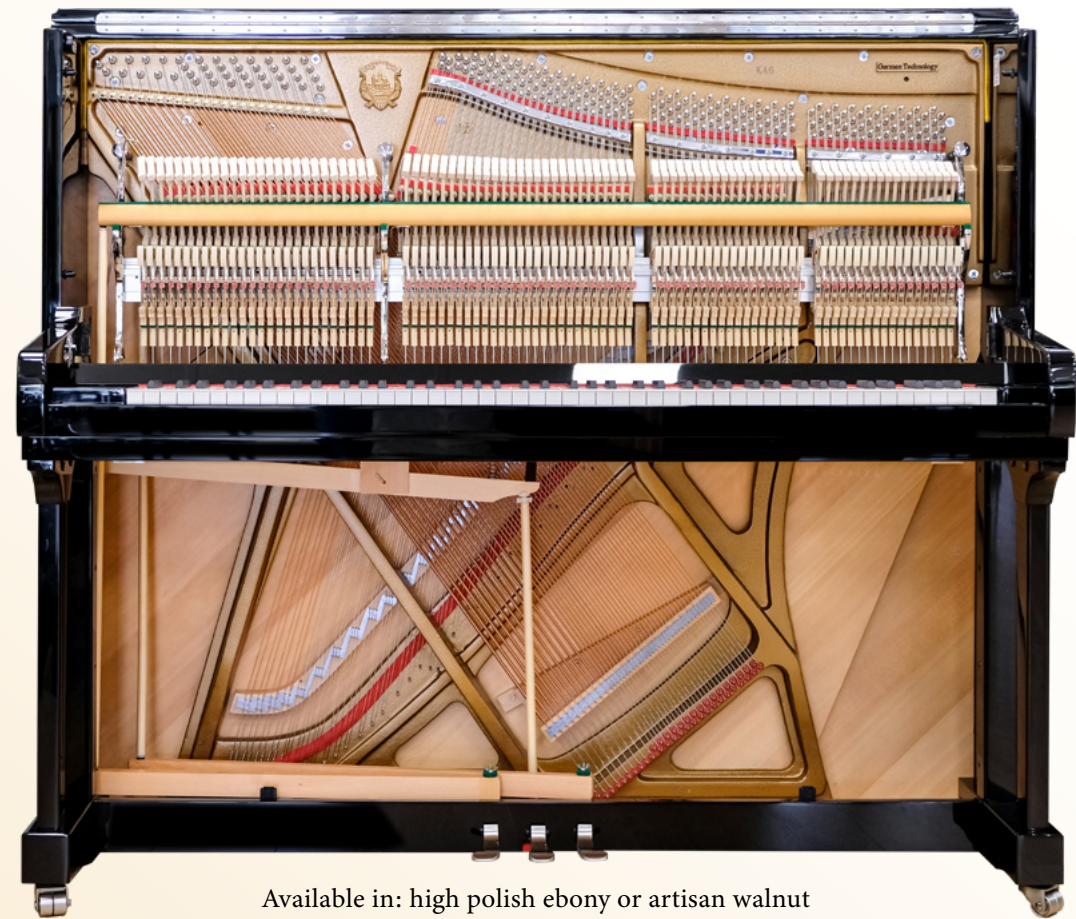

Keybed	Butcher-block spruce
Keys	Solid straight-grained spruce, individually weighted. Solid maple buttons
Key Bushing	Special Japanese cloth to provide stability and reduce friction at the rail pins
Key Coverings	Naturals: Ivolan (German) mineral key tops Sharps: Genuine ebony wood
Pedals	Heavy solid brass – nickel plated; middle mute pedal
Pin Block	17-ply maple, cross banded
Plate	Traditional sand-cast pure iron, CNC machined and finished full perimeter
Ribs	Solid spruce, tapered and hand notched into rim/liner
Soundboard	Solid tight-grained European alpine spruce
Strings	Treble: Röslau (Germany) solid surgical grade steel Bass: Röslau (Germany) core, solid copper hand-wound wrap
Tuning Pins	Nickel-plated steel, cut thread
